


PROJECTION



Projection K-Zone was designed to provide a game type environment within a training facility. While the uses for Projection K Zone include fun competitions and games, its true value is the environment that it creates during practice. Whenever spectators are present and results are being recorded, the intensity in practice increases.

We believe that an intense, competitive practice environment is the key to player development. We also believe the ability to track a player's progress, without bias, is a valuable tool for players, coaches and parents.



Projection K Zone currently features training with a catcher who moves and a batter. But coming soon is the first video game, where you can design the opposing team's lineup and players can throw a simulated game. See the back of this brochure for more information on simulated games.

BlackSound Sports, Inc. has taken sonic technology developed for NASA and the U.S. Navy and applied it to sports. The K-Zone's patent pending technology uses sensors to determine ball location and we have integrated the Stalker Sport Radar gun to record velocity







Backyard K-Zone was developed to help the serious player throw more and develop command. It makes training fun and records results, two key factors in developing positive practice habits. Because results can be recorded, Backyard K-Zone creates competition in every drill and at every practice. Adding a radar gun can help players develop an effective velocity for every pitch.

Software

Training software allows you to design customized bullpen sessions, requesting pitch type and pitch location. After each pitch, the software displays accuracy and velocity and the results are saved under the player's name. Results from each training session can be printed and there are 6 report options. This makes progress easy to track and provides impartial feedback.

Simulated Game Software

"Turn the Lights on Every Night" with simulated game software. We are developing game software that will let you design the opposing team's lineup and pitch a simulated game. The accuracy of the player's pitches determines the batter's response and the outcome of the game with outs, hits and runs all displayed.

Multi player mode will allow players to compete against one another in a heads up game and the results of each game can be printed. Because the batter reactions are based on probability algorithms and statistics, no two games are the same. If you have ideas for the game, please contact us immediately.
